Discuss any concerns that I have about my child with their teacher and ensure my child understands the importance of following the 'Golden Expectations'.	Be gentle and honest always using nice words.
Treat everybody equally, encouraging good behaviour and respect for themselves, others and property.	Support the School's behaviour policy and take responsibility for the behaviour and actions of my child.	Look after property and replace anything that I damage intentionally or through misuse.
Provide information on the progress being made by your child involving you in their targets and giving advice about how you can best support their learning.	Support events organised by school whenever possible including attending parent / carer consultation meetings and respond to my child's yearly written report.	Talk to my teacher and parent/ carers about my targets and what I enjoy and can do well at school
