Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Wrap around Care

It is with great excitement that I write to inform you that on one of his many days visiting the school, that Mr Phillips has begun to work alongside myself, the staff team and Governing body to reintroduce wrap around care at St. Lukes C of E, to further support you all as working parents.

With this in mind, Mr. Phillips and the team plan to trial providing an after-school club from Wednesday 4th September, 2024, with a view to it continuing, dependent upon pupil family engagement.

Please find below a list of times for our wrap around care provision. All sessions must be booked and paid for online through Parent Mail prior to attending. As we are cashless school, we are unable to take cash payments.

The timings for the club are as follows:

Teatime Club (Monday to Friday)

First Session: 3:15pm - 4:15pm - £5.00

Full session - including a light tea (Monday to Thursday only)

3:15pm - 5:30pm - £10.00

The first session will include one of our usual daily clubs, which will continue to be run by Mrs. Green. The clubs will continue to be themed around the variety of club options familiar to yourselves, including: gymnastics, arts and crafts, cooking, Hockey, Football, gardening, Tag Rugby and many more. These clubs will vary, dependent upon the season and pupil interest. We hope to have the timetable with you very soon.

Pupils who remain for the full session, up to 5.30pm, will receive a choice of a light tea from a selection of options including: beans on toast, cheese/ham sandwiches, cheese on toast or hot dogs etc.

We hope that in time, should there be a demand, we would be able to offer a before-school breakfast club from 8am each day, too.
