What have we been learning about this week?

We have had a great first week back this week and have been starting a range of new learning. Our topic for this half term is 'Football Fever' and as part of this we have been reading 'The Unlucky Eleven' in English, learning about adjectives and generating our own ideas for a new football-related mystery story.

In Reading, our focus text is 'Fergal is Fuming' and this gave us the opportunity to think about how we control our own anger and frustrations, suggesting different ways to do this. We read the text, made predictions, identified key vocabulary and made inferences about the characters all in this week!

In Maths, we move on to fractions and have been focusing on equal groups, a half and a quarter. Children have been working super hard and have a good understanding of these concepts so far - well done!

Our historical enquiry centres around Walter Tull this half term, who is a famous footballer from the past who had to change jobs to become a soldier in World War One. We will be learning much more about his life, but this week focused on using photographs as historical sources of evidence, thinking about what we could find out about Walter from the images provided.

Our PSHE lessons over the next few weeks are focusing on personal safety, so we started this week by learning about hazards in the home, electrical safety and fire safety.
