What have we been learning about this week?

Our week has been super special this week as we had the arrival of our eggs on Monday! This meant that our hatching days were Wednesday and Thursday and our eggs have done so well! We have been able to move some over from the incubator to the breeder box, where they will be fed and cleaned each day by us. This week, we have also been habitat helpers! We put our hedgehog house and food in our field and have been checking back to see whether we can see any signs of hedgehogs. We have also put out some bird food and have been keeping an eye on this too so that we can top it up when we need to!

In Science, we have been working on the structure of a plant and went outside to see some of the lovely flowers that have grown down the paths. We identified the stem, roots, petals and leaves and learnt more about the job of each part.

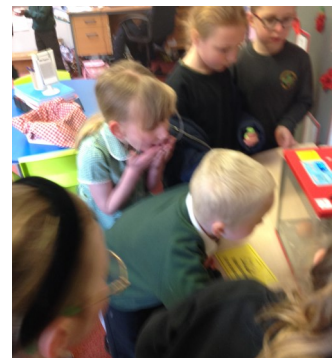
