What have we been learning about this week?

We have been working hard this week on our writing and basic non-negotiables, such as capital letters and full stops. We are now beginning to edit each piece of work to try and identify and correct our own mistakes.

We have been learning about characteristics of a narrative in English and will be writing our own stories next week! In Reading, we continue to study 'Elvis the Squirrel' and have been taking on different roles in the story, thinking about questions we might like to ask each character.

In Maths, we have been measuring in centimetres and metres and also comparing and ordering lengths and heights. We learnt how many cm are in a m, how many m are in a km and how many mm are in a cm. Can you remember all of these?

In Geography, we have been studying the features of hot and cold places, beginning to think about animals that live in these climates and how they have adapted.

In PSHE, we have spent the last couple of lessons learning about money - how we earn it and how we spend it. As you can imagine, there were some very interesting thoughts on this! Children are aware that we earn money through work and jobs and have been thinking about what they like to spend money on, as well as things adults have to spend money on.

In PE, we have been developing our tennis skills, using rackets to hit the ball and completing short rallies.

This week's homework task is an arithmetic sheet and a reading comprehension. Please try to complete these independently if you can, but if help is needed that is fine.
