What have we been learning about this week?

We had a great time on Thursday taking part in World Book Day - everyone looked amazing! We took part in a talk from an author, read a range of different books and even created our own! In Maths, we have been learning more about different forms of measurement and have been measuring the mass of items in grams. We used scales and read them to identify the mass of each object. We also learnt about kilograms too.

In Science, we completed an experiment relating to evaporation - can you explain to your grown up what we did? We had to make a prediction, explain our method and also note down the results.

We have been playing instruments in Music, trying hard to identify and play different notes. We worked together to play a melody as a class and learnt more about where the different keys are on a glockenspiel!

In PSHE, we continue to learn about money and have been discussing the difference between wants and needs. We talked about things we might want and how these things are paid for, drawing on our prior learning.
