What have we been learning about this week?

We have written, edited and performed our Gold Writes this week, which were narratives based on our book 'Flotsam'.

In Maths, we have moved on to learning about shape! We have been able to identify and name 2D and 3D shapes, then thinking about the number of sides and vertices on each 2D shape. We have also drawn 2D shapes and learnt more about symmetry within them.

In Geography, we have used maps again to locate the oceans around the world, learning that the Earth is a sphere and this is why the Pacific Ocean appears twice on the world map.

In Science, we have been learning more about germs and the importance of good hygiene. We discussed hand hygiene and also showering and brushing teeth.

We continue to complete dance activities in PE and this week focused on mirroring. We had to complete a series of movements whilst mirroring with our partners.
