Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Bikeability

For the first time at St. Luke's, from the week beginning 21st January, all children in Years 5 and 6 will have the opportunity to take part in Bikeability training including road safety on bikes. This will be led by specialist cycling teachers.

In order for the children to partake in this activity, the children participating need to be able to ride their bike unaided over a distance of at least 10 metres or more. The children will spend part of their instruction, learning how to ride their bikes safely on the school grounds, before taking the cycles onto the roads in and around the village (facilitated by specialist instructors).

If your child has their own bike and would like to participate, they will need to have their bike available in school on the day of their group session (to be confirmed) along with a helmet. If they have stunt pegs on their bike, these will need to be removed prior to the session.

It is possible for children to share a bike however we will need the consent of both families.

Please could you complete the attached reply slip and return to school, no later than Wednesday 15th January.
